1. **Road Green**

The first potholes have been filled at Road Green but we are in agreement that more needs to be done. I am due to meet with Yakub at Highways next week and this is on my list. If necessary some Highways Local money will be allocated to complete the remedial work.

2. **Pothole - Southend Farm**

This has been reported as a priority.

3. **Tyndale Close**

Following the AGM I visited the resident who made representation about cars being parked on the pavement at the entrance to the Close. There is no question that this thoughtless parking provides an obstacle for pedestrian / mobility scooter use as well as creating a hazard on the road. The road markings have almost disappeared, I have asked Highways to have them repainted. I would like to work with the Parish Council to create awareness of the need for residents or visitors to the shop not to park on the pavements. I will also be contacting the police for their advice on enforcement. At the same time, I looked at the small car park behind the 'Close' and have reported the rubbish which has been cleared from the empty property and had been left in the car park. Cllr Ken Tucker has this in hand. He is also establishing who owns the land and who is entitled to use it for parking. On the day I visited there were spaces.

4. Road Safety

I expect there to be an announcement in the next couple of weeks which may provide us with additional help to establish lower speed limits areas. I will contact the Clerk as soon as information is available.

This report is necessarily brief. There have been no other GCC announcements of relevance to residents in North Nibley. I have forwarded to the Clerk, the latest briefing regarding housing and education arrangements for the arrival of our friends from Ukraine.
